Professional (2019-present): Christopher signed with the Sioux Falls Storm during the 2019 season.

Senior (Tulane University, New Orleans, LA, 2016): Christopher started all 12 games as a senior at left guard after playing most of his time at Tulane at right guard. He anchored an offensive line that helped the Wave average 4.6 yards per rush attempt and 12.5 yards per pass completion.

- Taylor earned invite to participate in the 2017 College Gridiron Showcase & Symposium.

Junior (Tulane University, New Orleans, LA, 2015): Christopher started all 12 games as a junior at right guard. He helped the offense average 317.0 yards per game (201.2 passing, 115.8 rushing) as a starter on the offensive line.

Sophomore (Tulane University, New Orleans, LA, 2014): Christopher started all 12 games as a sophomore where he helped the offense average 346.8 yards per game (145.5 rushing, 201.25 passing) as a starter on the offensive line.

- He claimed Second-Team All-American Athletic Conference honors from Phil Steele Publications.

Freshman (Tulane University, New Orleans, LA, 2013): Christopher played in 12 games with four starts at right guard as a true freshman. He helped the team average 256.5 yards per game (84.8 rushing, 171.8 passing) as a starter.

High School (Zachary): Christopher was a three-year letterman where he helped the Broncos tally a 22-12-1 overall record, an 11-7 mark in district play, three trips to the state playoffs and a share of the District 4-5A title as a junior.

- He was rated a four-star recruit by ESPN.com while garnering three-star status from Rivals.com and 247Sports.com, and two-star status from scout.com.
- Taylor ranked the No. 8 offensive guard in the country by ESPN.com, No. 38 at the position by Rivals.com, No. 73 by 247Sports.com and No. 102 by scout.com.
- Christopher listed No. 190 in the ESPN 300 while receiving an 83 Scout Grade and listing as the No. 8 prospect in the state by ESPN.com.
- He was rated the No. 37 prospect in the state by Rivals.com and received an 82 rating and listed as the No. 57 recruit in the state by 247Sports.com.
- Taylor was also listed as the No. 39 recruit in the state in the Times Picayune Nifty 50.
- Christopher was named First-Team All-District and All-Metro in each of his final two seasons.
