Professional (2017-present): Darrian signed with the Sioux Falls Storm of the Indoor Football League (IFL) for the 2019 season. Miller played for the Sioux City Bandits of the Champions Indoor Football League (CIF) during the 2018 season. During the 2017 season, he played with Kansas City Phantom of the CIF.

- Darrian was named the CIF's League MVP in 2018.
- He was the CIF's Co-Offensive Player of the Year in 2018.

Senior (University of Northern Iowa, Cedar Falls, IA, 2014): Darrian finished second on the team in rushing yards during the 2014 season after transferring from Kansas. He finished the season with 91 carries for 332 yards on the ground, five touchdowns.

Freshman-Junior (University of Kansas, Lawrence, KS, 2011-13): Darrian saw action in eight games, starting one as a sophomore in 2013 where he finished the season as KU's second-leading rusher with 322 yards on 67 carries, averaged 4.8 yards per carry, finished with 11 kickoff returns for an average of 24.3 yards per return. He played in all 11 games during the 2011 season as a true freshman and finished the season ranked second on the team with 559 rushing yards and four touchdowns on 136 carries.

High School: Darrian recorded 88 career touchdowns. Miller ran for 2,226 yards and 30 touchdowns as a senior, rushed 309 times for 2,798 yards and 37 touchdowns as a junior and pulled in 24 receptions for 375 yards and three more scores.

- Darrian ranked as the second-best player in the state of Missouri, as well as the 22nd-best running back in the country by rivals.com.
- Darrian finished as the Missouri all-time big-class (5 and 6) rushing leader with 6,565 career yards.
- He was a three-time All-State First-Team selection and was twice named the Missouri Class 6 Offensive Player of the Year.
- Miller was named Kansas City Star All-Metro First Team as a senior. And was named the Missouri Gatorade Player of the Year as a junior.

Personal: Darrian is the son of Crystal Miller. He majored in liberal arts and sciences.
