Professional (2019-present): Donnie signed with the Sioux Falls Storm during the 2019 season.

Senior (Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, LA, 2017): Donnie played in nine games, starting eight times where he registered 51 tackles, one sack, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery. He missed bowl game vs. Notre Dame (shoulder).

Junior (Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, LA, 2016): Donnie played in all 12 games with two starts where he finished the year with 45 tackles, two quarterback hurries, one pass break-up and one interception.

Sophomore (Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, LA, 2015): Donnie played in 12 games with one start where he recorded 12 total tackles and one fumble recovery.

Freshman (Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, LA, 2014): Donnie played in 12 games with most of his action coming on special teams as a true freshman in 2014. He was one of 17 true freshmen to see game action for LSU. He finished with one tackle.

High School (Edna Karr): Donnie finished his senior season with 97 tackles, six sacks and two interceptions. He racked up 137 tackles as a junior.

- Alexander was rated a four-star prospect by ESPN.com.
- He was a composite three-star recruit by 247Sports and ranked as the 19th overall outside linebacker prospect by ESPN.com.
- Donnie participated in the Offense-Defense All-American Bowl.
- He ranked as the 17th best prospect in Louisiana by ESPN and the No. 22 Louisiana prospect by 247Sports.
- Alexander was a member of the ESPN 300.
- He was honored on the Baton Rouge Advocate Second Dozen.
